## WHAT TO DO

### Whitstable

Whitstable is like no other town by the sea. Its traditional charms, strong arts culture and rich maritime history complement Whitstable's modern appeal. Whitstable's main claim to fame is its oysters which remain an intrinsic part of this town's character and are celebrated every July at the Oyster Festival. Oysters and other delicacies from the sea can be enjoyed at the local restaurants and pubs or taken home from the fresh fish market at the harbour.

### Faversham Brewery

At Shepherd Neame, brewing is both an ancient and a modern art. Their beer's main ingredient is still the same water that they used in 1698 but some of the systems they employ could only be products of the 21st century. From the Visitor Centre, you can join an award-winning guided tour, lasting 80 minutes, which will take you behind the scenes at this busy working brewery.

### Leeds Castle

Described by Lord Conway as 'the loveliest castle in the world', this magnificent 12th Century castle rises from two small islands in a lake. The interior is graced with splendid works of art including statues, carvings and tapestries. We 500 acres of attractive parkland stroll through the Wood Gardens, The Lady Baillie Gardens and The Maze. In addition, there is the Black Swan ferry boat and Falconry Displays at selected times of the year to enjoy.

### Canterbury

Canterbury's skyline is dominated by the stunning Cathedral, the oldest in England. But the cathedral is only part of the story; the ancient ruins of St Augustine's Abbey and St Martin's Church form Canterbury's UNESCO World Heritage Site while other ancient ruins such as the Castle are reminders of the city's history, heritage and culture.
